Dear Partners in Permanence,

We have had a thrilling year at Anu Family Services. Our new name and identity this year brought with it our renewed commitment to permanence through the unveiling of our new mission, “We create permanent connections to loving and stable families.” for both children and vulnerable adults.

We have once again achieved outstanding outcomes for children in out-of-home care. Our passion for ensuring that every child has as many permanent connections to their family and other caring adults has resulted in the children being placed in Anu Treatment Foster Homes being adopted or returned home to their family 57% of the time. In addition, 95% of these children experience only one placement at Anu Family Services; they do not move from foster home to foster home.

Our commitment to permanence increases a child’s sense of hope and belonging which fosters well-being and positive outcomes. This year, we are performing outreach with our partners to provide no-cost training in the evidence-based practices that increase permanent outcomes for children in care. We continue to work to secure additional resources to support our nationally-recognized successes in achieving permanent connections for children. We believe that each child has the right to a permanent family and a place to call “home” forever.

Thank you for your commitment this year to help us create more permanent connections than ever before! As you consider your on-going support for our work to create permanent families for each child, we ask you what we ask ourselves, “What would be good enough for your own child, or a child you love?”

95% of children remained with the same family during care.

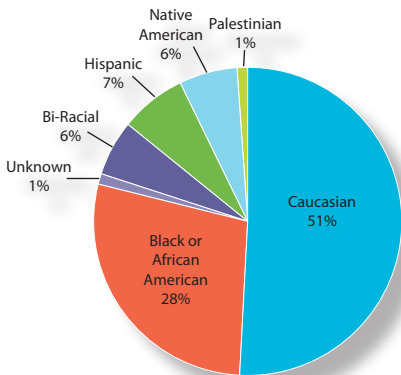
168 TFC children were

restraints to ZERO.

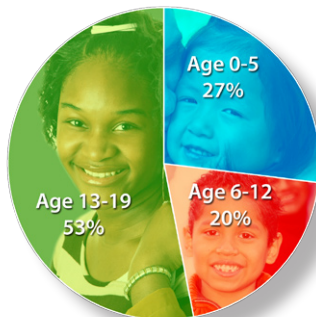
The number of children experiencing

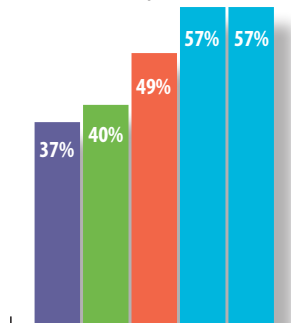
Children by Race/Ethnicity
